The decline of Bengaluru's rivers

“It was another boring Monday. Like as if I would go sight-seeing to the Subramanyapura Lake, I looked at with surprise. The lake was usually always looks dirty and polluted but today it had also looked like there was no water at all. During English period I shared this incident with my English teacher and she said to go home and research about how many rivers were their initially in Bangalore and How many are there now?

Bangalore was once also known as city of 1000 lakes.

During 16th century Kempegowda the founder of Bangalore and called Bangalore as the city of thousand lakes. Due to climate change, pollution, population, pressure and extreme land use, they are declining at an unpredictable rate, 42 lakes have disappeared in the month of September 2022. According to the BWSSB, the city faced a short fall of 650 million liters per day in 2021 and this is likely to go up by 1450million liters by 2031. Out of all, areas such as Whitefield and HSR Layout are facing massive water storage. But why are the lakes disappearing? Most lakes in Bangalore now are man-made. But the rest originate from big rivers all from north and from the locality like Kaveri. These rivers are drying up and thus, even the lakes which originate from them are drying too. Whereas for the other man-made lakes, the main cause would be pollution and extreme land use among others. The biggest question is how can we solve this? Lakes are usually covered up with soil to build houses, this has to be stopped. People also dump their garbage into these lakes which has to be stopped. One voice could never stop the problem. If we join our hands raise our voice and debate about this problem We can save our lakes before its too late.
